Trump Tariff Threat

US President Donald Trump imposed tariffs on various countries, including allies like India. According to Trump's Reciprocal Tariffs, US's archival China has faced the maximum—34 per cent tariffs on its goods coming to the US.



In response to the terror attack in Jammu and Kashmir in April in which 26 people were killed, India launched Operation Sindoor to target terror bases in Pakistan. India struck at nine terror sites in Pakistan's Muridke, Bahawalpur, Muzaffarabad, Sialkot, Narowal, and Pakistan-occupied Kashmir. After India's strike, 13 people were killed in India due to Pakistan's shelling near the Line of Control (LoC).

Dr. Manmohan Singh Passes Away

Former prime minister of India, Dr. Manmohan Singh, died at the age of 92 after a 'sudden loss of consciousness'. Singh was the prime minister from 2004 to 2014. He played a key role in 1991 as the finance minister when India carried out major economic reforms.

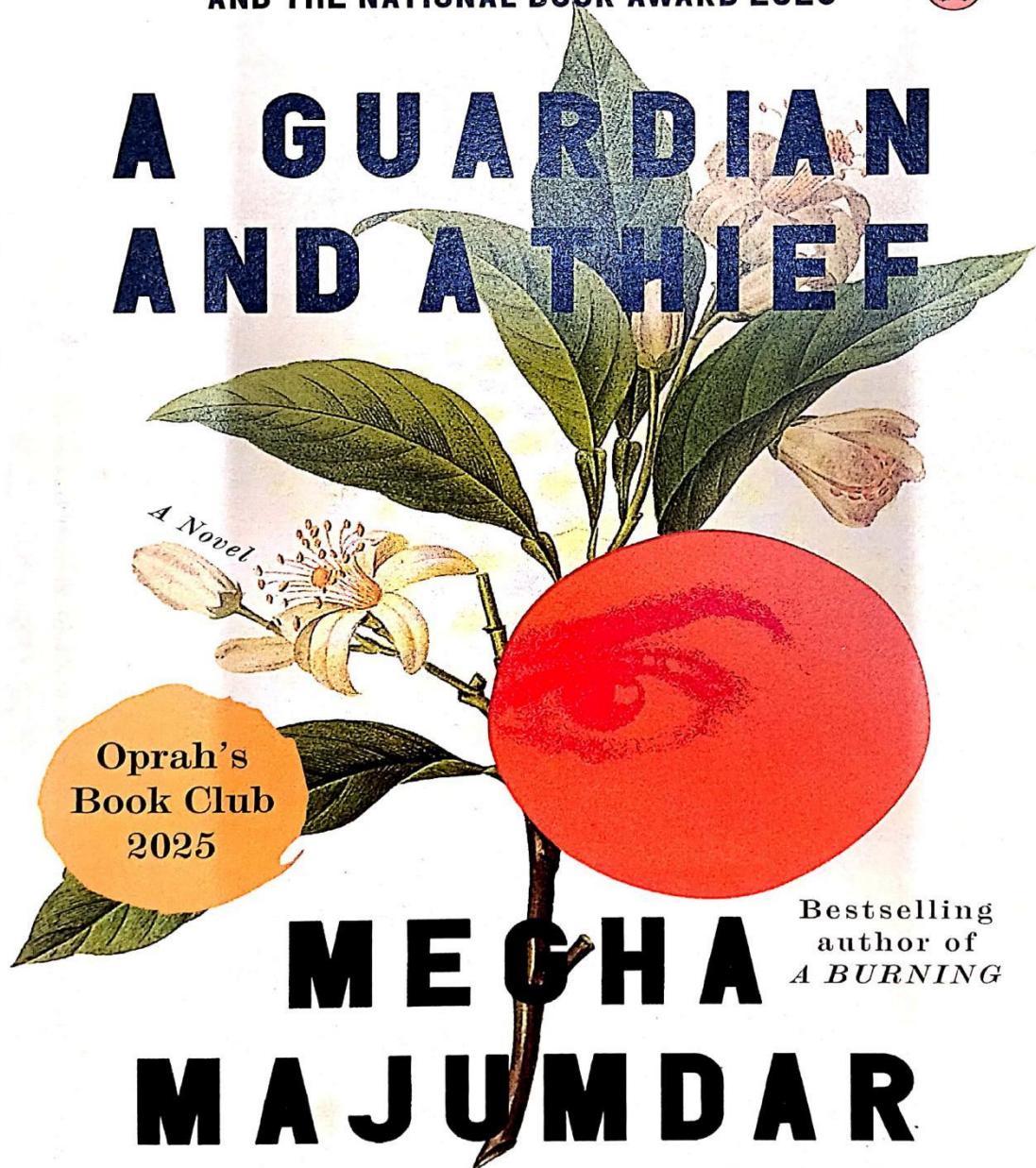

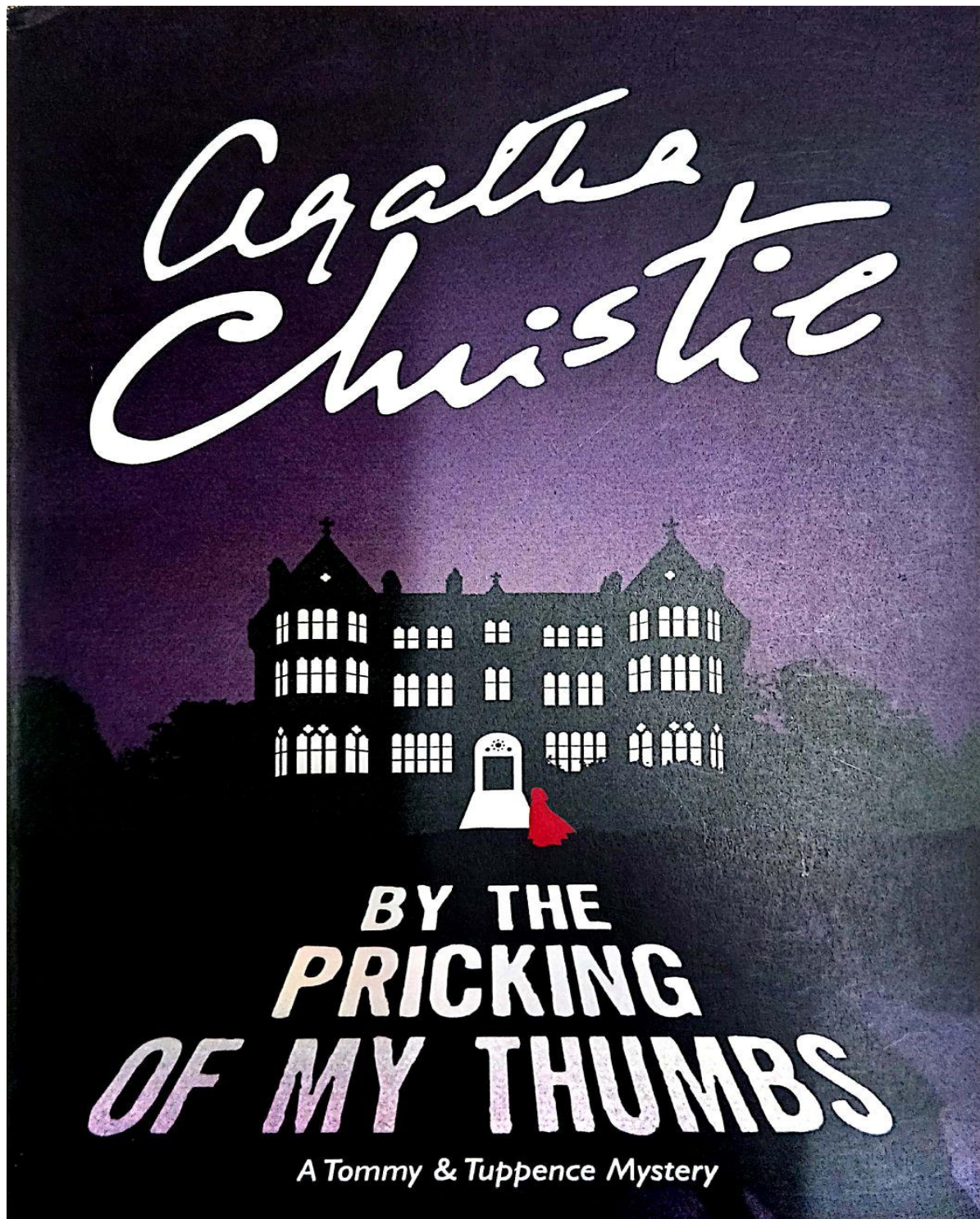

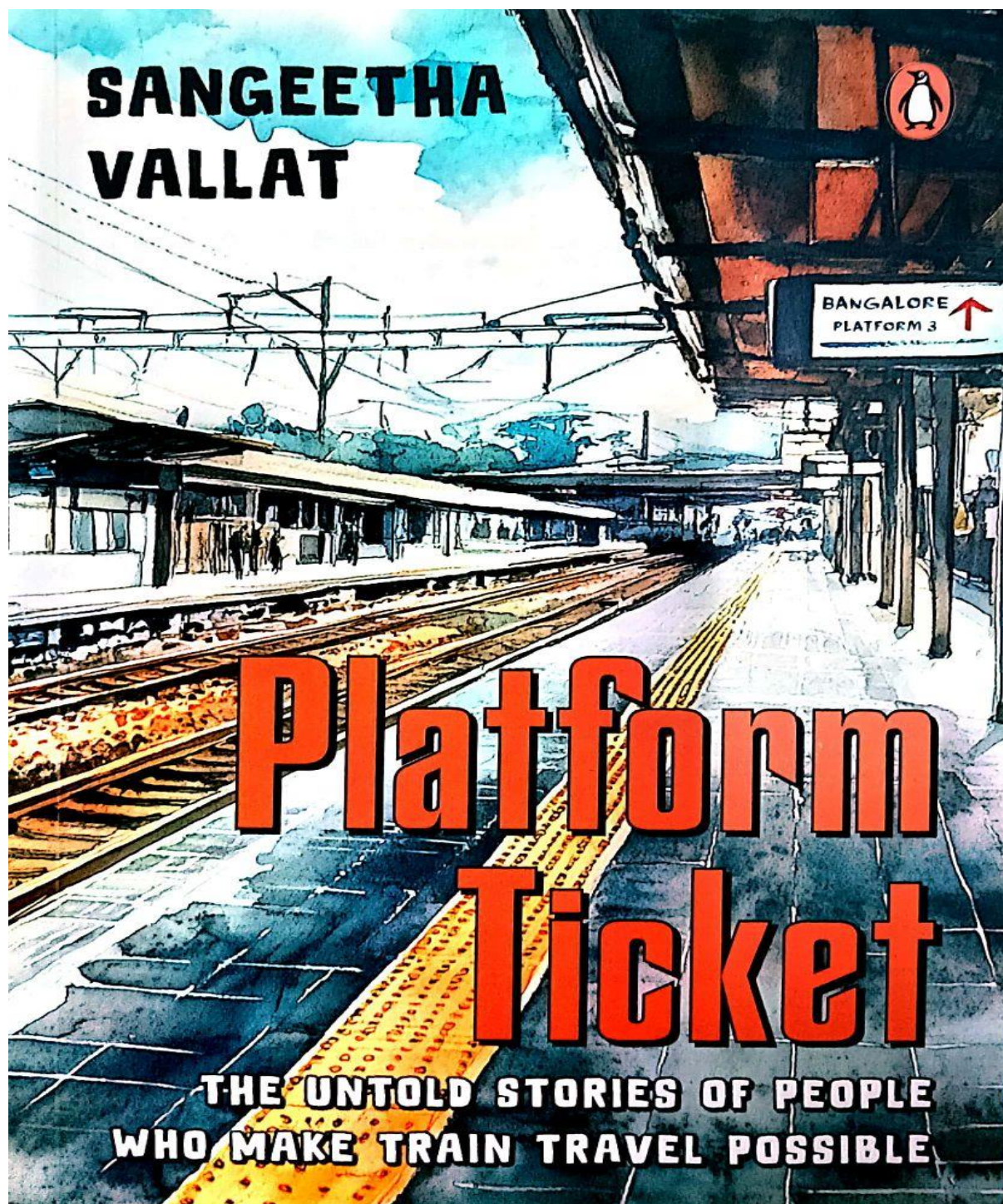
